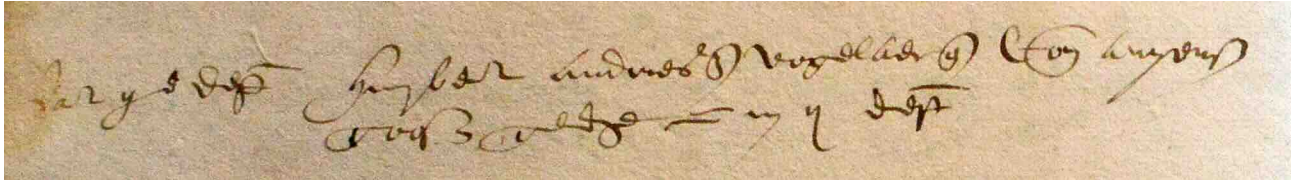
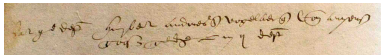

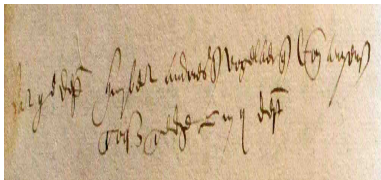


`\externalfigure[testfile.jpg]` [width=5cm]



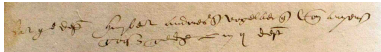
Explanation: height scaled proportional to the width reduction.

`\externalfigure[testfile.jpg]` [width=5cm, sy=0.999]



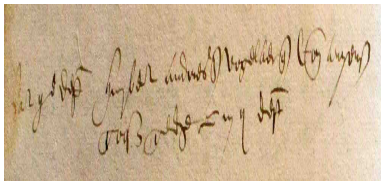
Explanation: sy different from 1.0 applies sy to original height.
